Dear Marc:

As you know, we have been retained by the Ad Hoc Committee of Arahova Noteholders (the "Arahova Noteholders Committee") in connection with the above referenced Chapter 11 cases. I write to request the Debtors' consent to permit the Arahova Noteholders Committee to pursue certain intercompany causes of action on behalf of Arahova Communications, Inc. ("Arahova").

In particular, we understand that on or about September 28, 2001, Adelfia caused Arahova to transfer, without consideration, legal entities which accounted for approximately 460,000 subscribers to its parent, ACC Operations, Inc., and ultimately to Olympus Cable Holdings LLC ("Olympus"). The transfers were accomplished by dividending up the stock/interest in four former Arahova subsidiaries, Arahova Holdings, LLC, Century Cablevision Holdings, LLC, CCC-II, Inc. and CCH Indiana, L.P. to Arahova. Arahova then dividended up the stock/interest to it is parent, ACC Operations, Inc. ACC Operations, Inc. then distributed the stock/interest to Olympus Communications L.P. which ultimately distributed the stock/interest to Olympus.

Our preliminary investigation of these transfers indicated that Arahova did not receive any consideration in connection with the transfers and that such transfers (i) were made at a time when Arahova was insolvent and/or (ii) rendered Arahova insolvent.

As you know, both the Debtors and the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors in these Chapter 11 cases are hopelessly conflicted from pursuing these claims on Arahova's behalf. Given the significant value of the assets (in excess of \$1.5 billion) that were transferred from Arahova to Olympus, the Arahova Noteholders Committee stands ready, willing and able to assert such claims on Arahova's behalf. Accordingly, we request that the Debtors agree to


